

Acessories Moldings



T molding is used when transitioning between two floors that are of equal height or within ½" in height of each other. It is a type of floor molding that helps streamline the flow of your home when two different types of floors meet. It serves as a transition space between these rooms and floors, creating a seamless flow between different textures and styles. This makes it a great option as bamboo transitions into laminate flooring or hardwood flooring between your kitchen, bathroom, and living room.



Reducer moldings are used when two floors of slightly different thicknesses come together, such as a laminate floor and a wood, vinyl, ceramic or low-pile carpet floor.



Stair nose molding is used in conjunction with floor installation to finish off the step or stairwell where the floor stops. Stair nose molding is about 5 inches wide, with a rounded bullnose edge that extends down to cover the edge of the step
